The Mount Vernon Economic Development Corporation met for a regularly scheduled, quarterly board meeting on Tuesday, November 10, 2015 at 5:30 PM in City Hall.

Board Chair Weidman called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM and opened the floor for public comment. No public comment was given.

Kenneth Shelton made a motion to approve the consent agenda, and Josh Jordan seconded the motion. The Board voted to approve and adopt all items on the consent agenda as follows:

- A. Minutes July 14, 2015
- B. Minutes August 11, 2015
- C. Financials July 1, 2015 September 30, 2015

Darrek Ferrell gave an update on the progress of the Site Investigation Report being completed by Adams Engineering for the Business Park Project. A report from Adams Engineering is expected at the next quarterly meeting in January.

The Board heard from Dr. Jean Latortue about planned expansion at the Franklin County Family Health Clinic as well as efforts to maintain the facility after the closing of the East Texas Medical Center. The Board reached a consensus to have the Executive Director work with Dr. Latortue to structure an incentive package.

Darrek Ferrell provided a demonstration of ArcGIS Online and Business Analyst Online, two subscription-based tools provided by Esri, Inc. The Board reached a consensus to direct the Executive Director to purchase and utilize a subscription to benefit the economic development efforts in Mount Vernon.

The Board considered the adopting a recommendation for the appointment of a new member following the resignation of Sherry Harvey. After receiving a report from the Executive Director that only one of the eligible candidates recommended at the previous meeting was available to serve, the Board elected to take no action on this recommendation. Instead, the Board reached a consensus to direct the Executive Director to consult with the City Council about the potential of amending the existing bylaws to allow for greater flexibility within the pool of eligible candidates. The Board also indicated that this

was in no way a rejection of the one available and eligible candidate but an effort to provide greater flexibility for all current and future appointments.

In the Executive Director's Report, Darrek Ferrell discussed his attendance at the Texas Economic Development Council's Annual Conference in October.

The Board recessed into Executive Session at 6:20 PM for deliberation regarding economic development matters as follows:
